The MIP program has one annual application deadline in early January, by which applications are due. Application Materials

Applicants from the GSB must request to have their original application sent to MIP for review. Applications can be forwarded as a PDF file to jjachter@stanford.edu and meghanfm@stanford.edu. Additionally, submission of the following is required for consideration:

- Dual Degree Application Form
- Stanford Official Transcript
- A confidential letter of support from a Stanford faculty member
- A current resume or CV
- A list of the quantitative coursework completed during your undergraduate studies and while at the GSB, especially in macroeconomics and microeconomics
- Statement of Purpose (2 pages detailing your background, your interest in adding the MIP program to your course of study, and your career goals)
- Additional Essay (Prompt: The MIP community is small and close-knit. We strive for a culture of support, collaboration, consideration, and gratitude. Our values include mutual respect, integrity, diversity, and accountability. What resonates with you and why? Please provide examples. Your answer should be one or two paragraphs in length and may not exceed 500 words)

Note: If your application is approved, you will need to submit a Graduate Program Authorization Petition (via Axess), and a Tuition Agreement for Students with Multiple Programs (available on the eForms portal in Axess)
